Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Members of the Mayfield Community,

Mr Humphries, our Attendance and Persistent Absence lead, recently met our Attendance Ambassadors, to seek children's views about Attendance and how we can make it even better.

Children told us that when they are late, they feel sad and unhappy.

They told us they feel this way because they worry about missing things and their learning.

Children had some good suggestions about how to make things better. Ideas included:

- Waking up for school earlier
- Getting ready for school quickly
- Becoming an 'Attendance Hero'.

Children told us that when they are absent, they sometimes feel upset and annoyed.

They feel this way because they want to come to school but sometimes can't, they want to see their friends and they worry about missing out on things.

Children said that only being off when they are sick will make it better and not going on holiday in school time.




