These values underpin everything we do in school and provide a common language, understood by children and staff.

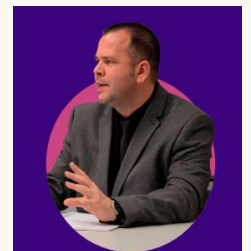
Values include 'love of all', 'empathy', 'reflect', 'never give up', 'lead by example' and 'perseverance'.

We are so proud of our children and the progress they have made this year. Good luck Year Six!

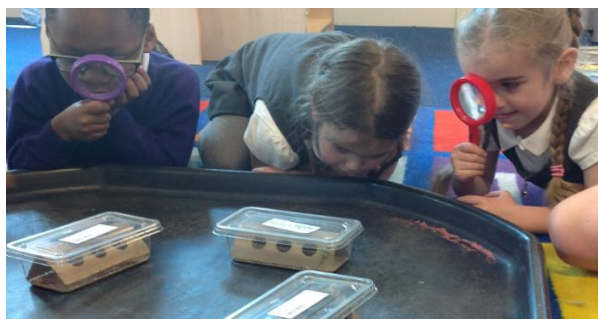
Little Princess Trust

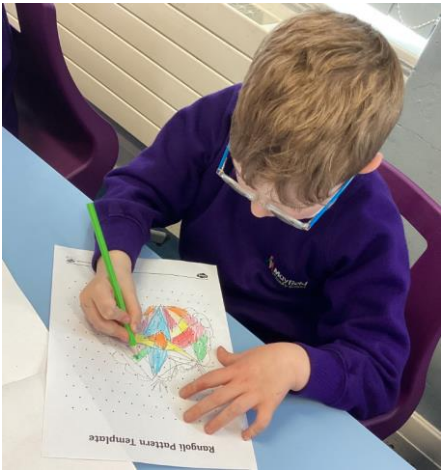
