Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Members of the Mayfield Community, A few weeks ago I shared that from September 2024, I will be Executive Headteacher, leading both Mayfield Primary School and East Crompton St George's, our sister school.

Each week I will spend some time at Mayfield and some time at St George's.

To enable me to lead two schools, we have increased the leadership capacity at both Mayfield and St George's. Here is an outline of our new Mayfield leadership team.

We will have two Deputy Headteachers at Mayfield. One will be Mrs Davies, our current Deputy Headteacher, and Mr Roberts, who we appointed recently.

We have also appointed Miss Alderson as our Assistant Headteacher, leading Early Years and KS1.

She will continue as Business Manager for Mayfield, although she will work across other Trust primary schools some days each week.



Mrs Tyson

Mrs Tyson will continue as Mayfield's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Co-ordinator (SENDSCO) and member of our Leadership Team. She is an experienced teacher and leader, who many of you already know well.



Miss Davys

Miss Davys is a member of our Leadership Team and will be 'Quality of Education Link' at KS2, lead Writing, Able and Talented, and develop teachers at the initial stages of their career as Induction Tutor and Professional Mentor.



Miss Timperley

Miss Timperley is a member of our Leadership Team and will be 'Quality of Education Link' at EYFS and KS1, lead Maths and be school's Mental Health and Well-being lead.
